4. Innovative technologies for managing enterprise development and business processes (economics,

organization, finance and taxation, accounting, analysis and audit, and other activities).

5. Modern mathematical methods, models, and information technologies in the context of global digitalization of economic systems as the instrument for developing a circular economy.

6. Realities and prospects of public administration and regional management: world and domestic experiences of efficient economic management at national and regional levels.

7. Education management: innovative teaching methods and up-to-date teaching technologies for training future professionals.

**The official languages of the conference are Ukrainian and English.**

The decision on publication is made by the editorial board. Papers that do not meet the requirements and thematic areas and papers unedited or submitted late will not be published. Materials sent to the conference organizing committee will not be returned.

The conference is held to highlight the advanced scientific and practical research results obtained in the field of modern management in the face of global challenges. The conference is meant to encourage the exchange of ideas and thematic information between Ukrainian and foreign scientists and representatives of scientific and business communities and to serve as a source of information about the current level of scientific work for higher education students.

**The Conference Dates**

The date of the conference in the Internet mode is **May 30, 2025**.

The conference proceedings are to be compiled within a month from the conference date.

**Terms of Participation**

*All conference materials meeting the requirements must be sent to the conference organizing committee no later than May 30, 2025.*

After submitting the materials, **be sure** to expect a confirmation of receiving them.

**Requirements for Conference Papers**

1. The participant submits a paper that has not been published before. The maximum number of authors per report is three.
2. The length of a paper is **up to 2-3 full pages**. Pages are not numbered.
3. Paper format – A4, typeface – MS Word, font – Times New Roman, size – 14, style – Normal, line spacing – 1.5; text alignment – justified, paragraph indent – 1.25.
4. Margins: top, bottom, right, and left – 20 mm.
5. In the upper right corner – the number of a thematic area, the author's name and surname (**in bold**), scientific degree, academic rank, position (for undergraduate and postgraduate students, the surname and initials, scientific degree, and academic rank of their scientific supervisors are given), name of the institution, city, and country (normal type);
6. Below – double-spaced – the report title (**in bold**, center alignment).
7. Below – double-spaced – the text of the report.
8. If necessary, **References** are given below the text, double-space (**in bold**, center alignment). The reference list is formatted in accordance with the requirements of the Ukrainian National Standard DSTU 8302:2015. In-text citations are given in square brackets in the order of mention.
9. Using illustrative materials and formulas in conference papers should be minimal. Formulas, figures, and

illustrations should be created using computer software in black and white without a background (scanned materials are not acceptable). Incorrectly designed graphical materials will not be accepted. Tables and figures should be in book format only. Figures should be given in black and white. Formulas, tables, and figures should be numbered.

10. Automatic hyphenation and references in the form of footnotes are not allowed.

11. **Indicate the first author's surname and the number of a thematic area in the filename as in the example:**
